Recipe of the Month

CHOCOLATE COBBLER

Ingredients:

1 cup flour 1 cup packed brown sugar

1/2 cup sugar

1/4 cup cocoa

1 1/2 teaspoons baking powder

1 1/3 cups hot water

1/2 teaspoon salt

2 tablespoons cocoa

1/2 cup milk

3 tablespoons vegetable oil

Directions:

- 1. In bowl, combine flour, baking powder, salt, sugar and 2 T. cocoa
- 2. Stir in milk and oil until smooth.
- 3. Pour into a greased 8 inch square baking pan.
- 4. Combine brown sugar and the 1/4 cup cocoa.
- 5. Sprinkle over batter.
- 6. Pour hot water over the top (DO NOT STIR)
- 7. Bake at 350 degrees for 45 minutes or until cake springs back when touched. This cake makes its own chocolate sauce!!
