

Water Street, Woodbury, Tennessee 37190, in connection with the proposed plan of financing involving the issuance of not to exceed \$42,800,000 multifamily housing revenue bonds, in one or more series as part of a plan of finance (the "Bonds"), by The Health and Educational Facilities Board of the City of Dickson, Tennessee, the proceeds of such Bonds to be loaned to Housing Associates, LP and/or BTT Development IV, each a Tennessee limited partnership, to finance the acquisition and rehabilitation of certain existing multifamily housing facilities totaling approximately 515 units located in the following cities and counties in the State of Tennessee: Dickson, Dickson County; Woodbury, Cannon County; Brownsville, Haywood County; Chapel Hill, Marshall County; Springfield, Robertson County; Covington, Tipton County; Stanton, Haywood County; Somerville, Fayette County; Oakland, Fayette County; Trenton, Gibson County; and Henning, Lauderdale Coun-

Proceeds of the Bonds in the amount of not to exceed \$3,300,000 are to be loaned to Housing Associates, LP, a Tennessee limited partnership, to finance the acquisition and rehabilitation of an existing approximately 40 unit multifamily housing facility located at or near 310 South Dillon Street, Woodbury, Cannon County, Tennessee (the "Holiday House of Woodbury Facilities"). Housing Associates, LP will be the owner and operator of the Holiday House of Woodbury Facilities to be financed with the proceeds of the Bonds.

A public hearing (pursuant to Section 147(f) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended) will be held at the above location in connection with the proposed plan of financing involving the issuance of the Bonds and the location and nature of the Holiday House of Woodbury Facilities to be financed with the proceeds of the Bonds. At such public hearing there will be an opportunity for persons to express their views concerning the foregoing. Anyone may appear in person at such public hearing or submit written comments to be considered

The proposed Bonds will not constitute an indebtedness or obligation of the City of Woodbury, Tennessee.
