Five locations: two (2) Elementary schools, one (1) Middle/Elementary School, one (1) High school and one (1) Central office, including some portables. The bid will be to spray on a monthly basis starting in January 2023 through December 2024. You must be certified and licensed by the State of Tennessee in order for your bid to be considered.

Spraying should be done once a month at a convenient time for the schools at each location, in the cafeterias, halls, storage areas, concession stands, teacher's lounges and any other problem areas as needed.
