SCREENING AND REGISTRATION
 BY APPOINTMENT ONLY



In order to attend this year's screening and registration, you must call and make an appointment. The dates and times are listed below. Appointment slots are limited, so make your appointment as soon as possible. We are asking that only one adult and the child being screened attend this event. We also ask that all participants of this event wear a mask while they are in the building. Please call 629-201-4801 to make your appointment. All appointments must be made by 3:00PM on March 12th.

Please be advised: If your child is currently (2020-2021 school year) enrolled in our Cannon County Schools voluntary pre-kindergarten program, they will not need to participate in this event. You will be receiving a registration packet from your child's pre-k teacher. Once you have returned this packet to your child's teacher, they will be enrolled in Kindergarten, at their school of zone, for the 2021-2022 school year. This event is for any age appropriate child wishing to attend our voluntary school-based Pre-K program, as well as Kindergarten aged children that have not previously attended our school-based Pre-K. Please bring all documentation listed below, when you come to the event. In addition, attendance is encouraged for any 3 year old or child approaching 3 (within 6 months) who may be suspected of having a delay (Speech/ Language Delay, Developmental Delays, Motor Delays, etc.). The only thing you will need to bring with you from the following list is your child to be screened.

For children who will begin kindergarten this fall, they must turn 5 by Aug. 15. If you want your child to attend a voluntary pre-kindergarten class, they must turn 4 by Aug. 15.

1. Your child to be screened
2. Proof of residence (light or phone bill with your name and address)
3. Birth certificate (official copy)
4. Immunization record with proof of physical
5. Social Security Card
6. Proof of custody, if necessary
7. Verification of income for Pre-K registration only*your application will not be processed until this documentation has been turned in*
