This will include the purchase of ballot marking devices, ballot tabulators, tabulation system, high speed central vote tabulator, (possibly) electronic pollbooks, training, technical support, and Election Day support.

The Cannon County Election Commission serves 9500 registered voters. We have nine Election Day precincts, one early voting location, and currently twenty-six machines.

The voting system proposed to the Cannon County Election Commission must meet the following minimum requirements: certified by the U.S. Election Assistance Commission to the 2005 Voluntary Voting Systems Guidelines, certified by the TN State Election Commission and Coordinator of Elections, and should have accessibility features to allow voters with disabilities to vote privately.

#### **General Requirements:**

Proposals, bids, or responses will be accepted by the Cannon County Department of Finance no later than **10:30 a.m. March 9, 2023** (local time). Every document must be enclosed in an envelope clearly marked as a bid document. Any response, bid or proposal received after the above deadline shall be considered late, and will not be opened or considered. Bid prices must be valid for at least thirty (60) days.
