ATTENTION VOTERS
Please be prepared to show proof of identification when you go to vote Tuesday, March 5, 2024. **A voter must have a Tennessee or Federal government issued photo ID.** If no photo identification is provided, the voter will vote a provisional ballot and the voter will have until two business days after the election to return to the election commission office and show a valid photo I.D. or the ballot will be rejected. **Forms of acceptable identification (even expired) include a Tennessee Driver's License with your photo, United States Passport, Department of Safety photo ID, Photo issued by the Federal or Tennessee state government, United States Military photo ID or Gun permit card with your photo.** The voter can sign an oath stating he/she is indigent or have a religious objection to being photographed.

ATTENTION CANDIDATES
Display of campaign posters, signs or other campaign materials, distribution of campaign materials and solicitation of votes is strictly prohibited within 100 feet of any polling place. (TCA 2-7-111)
During the hours the polls are open, candidates are not to enter a polling place unless they are there to cast their vote. (TCA 2-7-103)
